ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers

The officers of the Fraternity, known as the Grand Council shall be: Grand President, Grand Vice President for Alumni, Grand Vice President for Collegiates, Grand Vice President for Development, Grand Secretary, Grand Treasurer, and Immediate Past Grand President.

Section 2. Qualifications

a) A candidate for Grand Council office shall be an alumni member of the Fraternity in good standing.

b) A candidate for the office of Grand President must have served in an elected Grand Council position for a minimum of 4 years, with no more than 2 years between the end of that biennial term of service and the start of the term for which elections are being held.

Rationale: To ensure that the incoming Grand President is an experienced Fraternity officer and very familiar with the current issues that the Grand Council is managing.
